National cadet corps (NCC) unit started since 2003. It belongs to 8 Maharashtra Girls BN NCC Mumbai Group "A". The Cadet strength allotted to this unit by battalion is 52. **Capt. AnaghaPadhye-Deshmukh** is looking after the unit as Associate NCC Officer since its inception.

The regular weekly parade of cadets is conducted on days as instructed by the Battalion between 7.00 am to 01:30 pm. The parade is carried out in six periods. The cadets warm up by taking physical training, and then various classes like drill, map reading, weapon training, health and hygiene and social services are conducted under the supervision of ANO and PI staff of the Battalion.

Beside the weekly parade NCC cadets participate and help in the various activities carried out by the NGOs and governmental authorities.

NCC organization organized various camps on Battalion and Group Level during the academic session. Each NCC cadet should attend atleast one camp which is a necessary condition for appearing "B" certificate examination and two camps which is necessary condition for appearing "C" certificate examination conducted by NCC organization.
