MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

And

ROTARY CLUB OF PALGHAR INTERNATIONAL DISTRICT 3141

For

**Establishment of Multi-Disciplinary Vocational Training centre for the differently abled
people in Palghar and surrounding districts**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on this 8th day of February 2021 between Sonopant Dandekar Shikshan Mandali's Sonopant Dandekar Arts, V.S. Apte Commerce and M.H. Mehta Science College, Palghar, Maharashtra (hereinafter referred to as Sonopant Dandekar College which expression shall include its successors and assigns) of the **ONE PART**, and

Rotary Club of Palghar International District 3141 (thereinafter referred to as Rotary Club of Palghar which expression shall include its successors and permitted assigns,) as the **SECOND PART**.

PREAMBLE:

WHEREAS the Sonopant Dandekar College has established in the year 1970 and started various Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Ph.D courses to train students to meet the diverse industrial demands and at same time cater to diverse and differently abled population.

AND WHEREAS Rotary Club of Palghar has established in the year 1994 and is associated with Rotary Club of International is a social organization working for the betterment of society. One of the core objective of social upliftment is through empowering differently abled population.

AND WHEREAS Sonopant Dandekar College and Rotary Club of Palghar desire to work together in the common area of Establishment of a Multi-Disciplinary Vocational Training centre for the differently abled population in Palghar and surrounding districts which will enable them to move from 'able to ability' ensuring better standard of living so that they can lead a life with pride and dignity.



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TO SIGN THIS MoU AS FOLLOWS:**

- 1) This MoU supersedes all previous correspondences, discussions, understanding and agreement on the subject matter of this MoU.

2) PERIOD OF THE MoU AND ITS EXTENSION

This MoU comes into effect from the date of its signing and will remain in force for five years. Its validity can be extended by mutual agreement in writing between the two parties.

3) SCOPE OF COLLABORATION

Sonopant Dandekar College and Rotary Club of Palghar desire to work together in the common areas of mutual interest as under:

Establishment of Multi-Disciplinary Vocational Training centre for the differently abled people in Palghar and surroundings which will enable them to move from 'able to ability' ensuring better standard of living so that they can lead a life with pride and dignity. Any activities ancillary or incidental thereto fall within the scope of collaboration. Further any activities which are mutually agreed by the both the parties to fulfill the following activities will also fall within its ambit.

OBJECTIVE OF SETTING UP A MULTI-DISCIPLINARY VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTRE:

- 1) To take specific measures and plan strategies for ensuring protection of rights of PwDs and their inclusion in the society.
- 2) To empower the differently abled population from Sonopant Dandekar College and those in adjacent areas.
- 3) To establish a vocational training centre for differently abled population. (Divyangjan) from Palghar College and nearby vicinity.
- 4) To collaborate with the Government and Industries for employment and training of these differently abled people.
- 5) To collaborate with the Department of Empowerment of Persons with disabilities for empowering differently abled population.
- 6) To promote economic development activities including self-employment, extend financial assistance/loans/concessional finance and other ventures for socio – economic benefit and rehabilitation of handicapped persons regardless of their religion, sex, caste and age, in collaboration with State Government Ministries/Departments.
- 7) Provision of infrastructure facilities to meet the needs of this group
- 8) Any assistance ensuring better quality of life for these differently abled people



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Proposed set up of Activities :

1. Advocacy and creating sensitization and teamwork for this community through Counselling Programs, Outdoor Sports and Cultural Events etc.
2. Health and Prevention: Through Team of Health Care Workers
3. Therapy Support: Physiotherapy, Speech Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Psychiatry
4. Fitness Centre and Gymnasium
5. Community Outreach programs
6. Financial Literacy Programs
7. Vocational Training Centres for conducting following but not limited to:
 - a. Computer Skills
 - b. Bakery and Confectionary
 - c. Tailoring and Embroidery
 - d. Nursery and Gardening
 - e. Pottery and Ceramic
 - f. Maintenance and repair of durables
 - g. Housekeeping and Catering
 - h. Dairy and Poultry Farming
 - i. Organic Kitchen Gardens
8. Providing Mobility aids to deserving people including Calipers, Braces, Triwheelers, Wheel Chairs, Jaipur Foot, hearing aids, etc.
9. Post Vocational Training Assistance:

The biggest challenge would be to provide job opportunities for the trained people. A good networking platform would be created wherein they need to be registered. There will now be connected with local companies, educational institutes to provide job opportunities and also make them part of the vocational training program. Care would be taken to ensure customization rather than following inflexible procedures. Few initiatives that would be taken through these collaborations are as listed below:

 - a. Provide Entrepreneurial opportunities like technicians, shops, internet services, computer database entry, tailoring, art and crafts, dairy farming, poultry farming etc with help of local communities.
 - b. Maintain their databases with the institute which would be shared with their prior permissions to ensure meeting of the ends.
 - c. Ensure their works reach out to the large population wherein the institute would organize trade fairs and exhibitions.
 - d. Registration of Self-Help Groups if required.

Roles and Responsibilities:

All parties of this MoU would work together seamlessly to fulfil the above objectives in phased out manner. However, the specific roles would be as follows:

1. Provide space and infrastructure in the college campus for the above activities in phased out manner.
2. Coordinate with the Local Government Bodies for approvals, support and collection of data on differently abled people.
3. Equip faculty and staff with necessary skills by mandatory enrollment for " Train the Trainer " program so that they can run this centre effectively and efficiently
4. Identify and select differently abled population between the age group of 16 to 30 years to be treated / trained in this facility
5. Coordinate and discuss with local institutions and corporates for placement of the trained youth and also fine tune the curriculum accordingly.
6. Fill in the industrial – academia linkages through value added courses.
7. Identify and enroll Advisors who are specialists in this field to guide us in the implementation of this project
8. Prof. Mahesh Deshmukh, Prof. Dr. Tanaji Pol, Prof. Vivek Kudu, Mrs. Priti Phansekar, Mr. Yatish Satavi, Mrs. Heena Shaikh will coordinate with all matters from Sonopant Dandekar College.

Rotary Club of Palghar:

1. Will be the main Rotary club sponsoring this project on a long-term basis for at least 5 years.
2. Work closely with Sonopant Dandekar College pursuant to establishment of Multi-Disciplinary Vocational Training centre.
3. Arrange for funding the project through local club funds, District Grants, Global Grants and CSR funds
5. Work closely on a day-to-day basis with Sonopant Dandekar College on this project.
6. Provide necessary support and guidance to this centre.
7. Identify and enroll Advisors who are specialists in this field to guide us in the implementation of this project
8. Visit the centre regularly to see the progress and also have joint meetings with Sonopant Dandekar College and Rotary Palghar
9. Monitor, evaluate and have a quarterly reporting system for progress of this project.
10. Rtn. Sanjay Mahajan, Rtn. Rafiq Lulaniya- District Secretary, Rtn. Ninal Shah President, Rtn. Depesh Thakur President elect, Rtn. Prashant Patil – Vice President, Rtn. Ninad Save, Rtn. Libreta Lobo will coordinate with all matters from Rotary Club of Palghar.

AMENDMENTS
